Dear yourMP

I am one of your constituents and I am distressed and appalled at the events taking place in Myanmar.

I am a supporter of a UK Registered charity (<https://www.ahtutucharity.org.uk/>) which supports people in South West Myanmar who are directly affected by the military coup and who are, frankly, terrified and have lost all hope for the future.

I am writing to seek to ensure that the UK government does everything possible to halt the current violence and oppression and to restore the democratically elected government to power.

I have been following the UK government's response to the coup and am heartened by the sanctions that have been imposed against key figures and the leading role that the UK has played in coordinating the UN's statements on the crisis.

Unfortunately, as you will be aware, there is a large body of evidence demonstrating that the behaviour of the regime is worsening so further action is crucial. Please can you let me know what the UK's strategy is for action both in its own right and as a global leader in championing human rights and democratic values?

- Will the UK lead a call for the UN general assembly to act via a "Uniting for Peace" resolution by, for example, recommending to all member states that they impose targeted sanctions and arms embargoes or by refusing to acknowledge any military delegates presented to the next annual session?
- Will the UK government continue to impose targeted sanctions and encourage its allies to do likewise?
- Will the UK government call on ASEAN to seek to negotiate a peaceful return to democratic governance in Myanmar and an end to military dominance?

I look forward to your response.
